The South East Kelowna Irrigation District (SEKID) is a public water utility providing domestic, commercial and irrigation service to the southeast portion of the City of Kelowna. The district has a position open for an operator experienced in both heavy equipment and water distribution system operations.

The successful candidate will have at least 3 – 5 years of experience installing, maintaining and operating water distribution systems, including instrumentation, pressure reducing valves, air valves and be familiar with a variety of pipe classes, sizes and types. A minimum certification as a Level 1 Water Distribution System Operator is preferred. Over time this position will assume responsibility for the routine maintenance and operation of the District's heavy equipment. Along with the ability to take on a diverse range of tasks and responsibilities, experience in excavation and repair of water systems in a multiple utility environment is an asset,

Preference will be given to candidates who meet the following criteria:

- High School Diploma
- Water Distribution System Operator Level I or higher
- Valid BC Drivers License – Class 3
- Related construction experience in waterworks installation
- Mechanical and equipment knowledge
- Available for weekend, on-call and stand-by shifts

This is an hourly wage position with a 40-hour work week. Remuneration will be based on experience and qualifications. The district has a comprehensive benefit and pension package available upon the successful completion of a probationary period.
